In addition, OCTC works with area partners, VICs and chambers to bring together the many individual tourism promotion efforts to achieve greater focus and economy to promote tourism for ALL of Okanogan County. In the online arena, OCTC's dynamic website showcases the incredible beauty, recreation and diversity in our vast county, as well as providing users all the printed materials in downloadable formats. All lodging in the county is listed free of charge in the Travel Planner Guide and on the Web Site, including all hotels, resorts, cabins, camping, and RV parks. ADDITIONAL MARKETING EFFORTS INCLUDE

- OCTC will again partner with, Okanogan Trails, Methow Trails, Cascade Loop and Coulee Corridor Scenic Byways, as well as communicate with the Washington Tourism Alliance, Scenic Wa, the Port of Seattle and others to increase visitor awareness and enjoyment of our Scenic Byways.
- OCTC will continue our informative OCTC E-Newsletter that promotes our many events and activities for potential visitors, travel writers, media partners, publications and regional tourism partners to lure visitors to Okanogan Country.
- OCTC will further explore the e-blasts and original content advertorials with partners such as MyNW.com and the Seattle Times.
- OCTC will also continue our HD video production for Okanogan Country and increase activity, traffic and subscribers to our YouTube channel. OCTC will create seasonal TV commercials focusing on winter and shoulder seasons. OCTC will work with Cascade Loop Association to create new video production for new video clips to use in advertising. Incorporate online video ads into our online ad campaigns and work with partners to get commercials into targeted TV campaigns emphasizing winter and shoulder seasons, with high visibility and results.
- OCTC will create eye catching, full-page color ads in select publications with regional partners. Emphasize big, bold images and branding Okanogan Country as a "must see" destination for everyone. Print ads will be placed in WA State Visitor Guide, Cascade Loop, Washington State Byway Map, and other key publications as selected and determined by the board.
- OCTC creates campaigns to target audiences on Google, Facebook, Pinterest, Instagram and Twitter and niche online publications with hyperlinked ads to OkanoganCountry.com
- OCTC will update and reprint the Official Okanogan Country Travel Planner 52 pages of tourist information, which includes all lodging in the entire county, events, maps and engaging stories about the colorful history and culture of Okanogan Country.

ADDITIONAL MARKETING EFFORTS CONTINUED...

- OCTC cirulates eye-catching rack cards for aggressive distribution in the greater Seattle area that draws visitors to check out the web site.
- OCTC has a Summer Recreation Map and a Winter Recreation Map for distribution at trade shows, direct mail, and at local VICs and local businesses. OCTC will update and reprint the incredibly popular regional maps as needed, including the Highland Historic Loop Map, the Many Lakes Map, and the Columbia River Region Map.
- OCTC produces a Hiking Guide and Fishing Guide that also highlights relevent member information.
- OCTC also produces a Public Arts Map (walks) for Okanogan Country.
- Conduct a gathering/info sharing session with local VICs/Chambers, museums, etc. This has proven to be an excellent opportunity for local VIC/Chambers to share the story of their area with other VICs and Chambers so they will be informed and can encourage visitors to spend another day in Okanogan Country. This is also an opportunity for those on the frontlines to provide feedback on the collateral pieces that are developed by OCTC.
- The Tourism Council will also help chambers and cities promote tourism-focused events by keeping the "Events Calendar" on the web site up-to-date and pushing the information out through our e-newsletters and weekly postings on Facebook. This will give these events great exposure and increase visitors.
- OCTC will update, manage and maintain the Official Okanogan County Tourism website, www.Okanogan-Country.com. Survey site visitors and members to ensure that content is easy to find and comprehensive. Entertain, inform and engage Social Media users with Facebook posts, Google+, You Tube, Pinterest, Instagram and Twitter. Present key information and create a dialogue with visitors. Use these Social Media platforms to also promote area events.
- Create cohesive, easy to follow suggested itineraries that include multi day, multi stay travel routes throughout the county.
- In cooperation with the local Chambers/VICs, OCTC will continue to help create beautiful kiosks to place at select VICs/Chambers/Museums/points of interest that will have large weatherproof county locator maps.
