Cost Share

Tom Everly, Sun Cove, presented a cost share application for further fuels reduction in his community. They would add 30 feet of river rock in the fire break. More maps and description details needed. Would start the project Spring, 2024.

Did not get funding for Bromiley fence this cycle. Too few endangered species (although right next to Breilers who did get funding) We will look for other funding opportunities.

Discussion on liability of SDCD on projects Foster Creek CD is working on within South Douglas' boundaries. Will see what documentation may be needed.

We did get the Community Wildfire Protection Plan funding for 136,500. Organization, etc. is starting. Deadline is June, 2025.
